Mestre Jamaika is an internationally recognized practitioner of the Afro-Brazilian art form of capoeira, a three-time Brazilian Capoeira Confederation champion, black belt in Jiu Jitsu, and owner and lead teacher of Salt Lake Capoeira since 2005. His exceptional skill, knowledge, and authentic preservation of his Afro-Brazilian roots have placed him among the most sought-after instructors within the capoeira and dance community, teaching and performing throughout the world for the past 30 years.
